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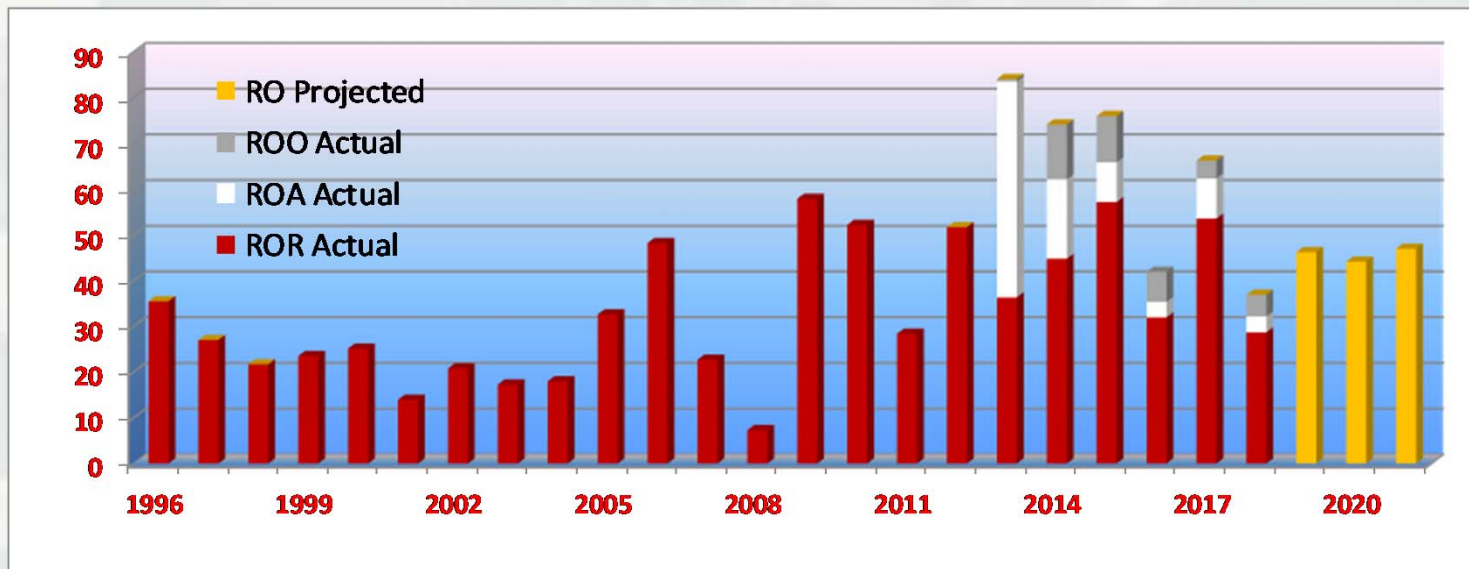

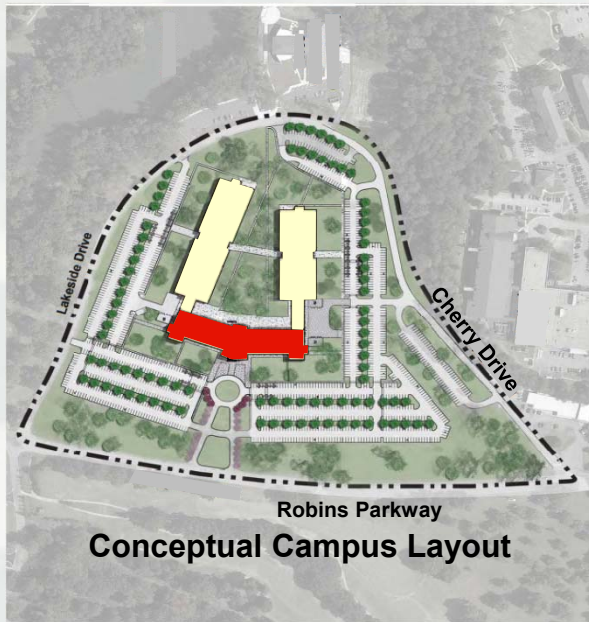

AMFP construction statistics at a glance:

- Demolished 2 existing WWII era buildings, including extensive abatement.
- Excavated 46,355 tons of contaminated (regulated) soil and transported to landfill.
- Placed 6,500 cubic yards of structural concrete.
- Erected 261 tons of structural steel framing.
- Installed four 2,500KVA transformers supplying 10,000KVA of electricity to the building.
- Provide 42,000 CFM from 12 AHU's, and 385,000 CFM of scrubbed exhaust in the wet process area utilizing galvanized, stainless steel and CPVC duct systems.
- Installed 106 pumps capable of 12,140 GPM.

Other systems installed:

- Fully automated over-head material handling systems for large component conveying.
- Self contained chemical waste treatment plant.
- Compressed & breathing air systems.
- Medium/high pressure steam & process/environmental chilled water systems.
- Explosion Proof Elec. system compliant with Class I, Div. 1 requirements.
- Phone/data communication, mass notification PA system, closed circuit TV.
- Fire alarm and repair detection systems.
- Wet & dry chemical fire suppression systems.

- Wet Process Area - Process Plating Area
- Dry Process Area - blast booths and associated dust collection equipment/industrial ovens/fluorescent penetrant inspection
- Laboratory
- Administrative space
- Wastewater treatment facility

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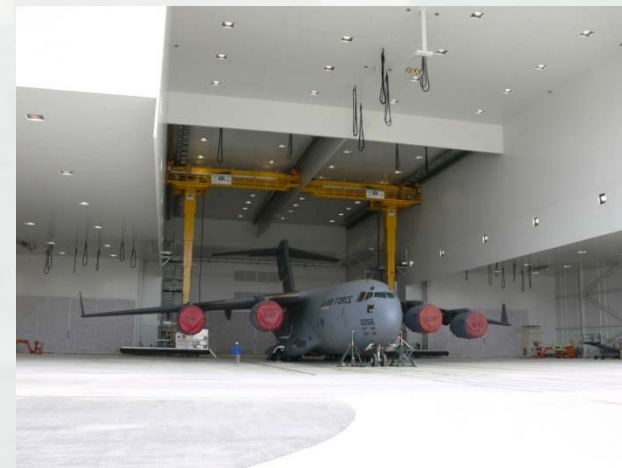
