#### Why We Need It

- Facility constructed in 1944; provides fire extinguisher support and life raft servicing to all A/C in inventory
- Safety RAC assigned due to structural failure of roof requiring employee evacuation when wind exceeds 35 knots
  - 6 evacuations in last 8 months
  - Production manhours lost 270



### Robins #1 P-341 Add/Alter Fire Station 1



Scope: Construct 4,700 SF addition; companion O&M project

#### Why We Need It

- Existing fire alarm no longer meets code
- HVAC system inadequate
- Roof frequently leaks—patched numerous times
- Bunkrooms do not meet OSHA standards







- Repair Upgrade Fuel Hydrant System Bldg 2089: \$19.9M
  - Under construction, ECD: Aug 18
- Perimeter Airfield Boundary Fence: \$1.9M (P-341)
  - Under construction, ECD: Dec 17
