Preview of the August 2018 SAME Presentation. This presentation will be about the 78th Civil Engineer Group Program Review and will be given by Mr. Marshall Wall of 78 CEG/CEN.

The 78th Civil Engineer Group is located on Robins Air Force Base, Warner Robins, GA. The Group is responsible for all facilities and infrastructure, emergency management, fire & emergency services, and environmental support across the 6,935 acre installation. The installation includes 92 miles of paved roads, 6.8 miles of fuel lines, and 1,178 facilities comprised of 13.8M square feet. Robins AFB also operates one of Georgia's longest runways, 12,001 feet long and 300 feet wide and over 18.7 million square feet of airfield pavements, averaging 23,000 flight operations each year. Robins AFB has grown to be one of the largest industrial facilities in the state of Georgia.
