Abstract: History of Engineering
Licensure

2007 marks two milestones in the history of the engineering profession as we celebrate 100 years of engineering licensure in the United States and 70 years of licensure in the State of Georgia. Mr. Mickler will delve into the national history of licensure beginning with Wyoming's first licenses in 1907, continuing with Georgia's first licenses in 1937 and finishing with the work that licensing Boards continue to do today, both separately and through their national organization, the National Council of Examiners for Engineering and Land Surveying.
