Intro

Air Force Chief Master Sergeant Morris (ret.) is the Command Emergency Management Program Manager for the HQ Air Force Reserve Command. He served 29 years in the Civil Engineer function, serving as the Air Force Full Spectrum Threat Response Program Manager and as the Civil Engineer Readiness Career Field Manager at the Headquarters Air Force Civil Engineer Support Agency. Additionally, he served as a contractor for the Pentagon supporting the AF Civil Engineering Emergency Management. The briefing will focus on the National Response Plan and the process a local emergency response uses to request additional support to mitigate the incident. The process will cover from when an incident exceeds the capability of the local emergency response forces, to State and Federal requests and also the request for support of military forces.
