Preview of January 2010 SAME Presentation, entitled "Solar Power Systems on Landfill Sites." This presentation will be given by Dr. Majdi Othman, PE, Principal, Geosyntec Consultants, Kennesaw, Georgia.

Solar Power Systems on Landfill Sites

This month's presentation will focus on the development of solar power systems on landfill sites. The presentation will include information about the different types of solar power systems currently being utilized at landfill sites and the advantages and issues associated with these systems. Design considerations, such as foundation bearing capacity, interaction with existing final cover system and existing structures, settlement, wind forces, access, surface water management, and durability will be discussed. The economics of solar power systems including land requirements, capital and O&M costs, revenues from power sales and renewable energy and emission reduction credits will be presented.

Presenter's Bio: Majdi Othman, Ph.D, P.E., Principal, Geosyntec Consultants

Majdi Othman is a Principal Engineer with Geosyntec Consultants in Atlanta, Georgia. He received a doctorate degree in geo-environmental engineering from the University of Wisconsin-Madison in 1992. He has 20 years of consulting experience in geotechnical, environmental, and civil engineering projects. His work focuses on waste disposal facility siting, design, permitting, and construction; design and permitting of bioreactor landfills; landfill air permitting and compliance; design and permitting of landfill gas collection and landfill gas to energy projects; renewable energy feasibility studies and implementations; hydrogeologic investigations and ground-water impact analysis and protection; remediation of contaminated sites; environmental monitoring; and construction management.



Majdi provided advisement to regulatory agencies including the U.S. EPA, California Integrated Waste Management Board, and Maine Department of Environmental Protection.

He has published 25 technical articles and guidance reports and gave many presentations and invited lectures. He provided peer review to publications in many first-rate journals and conference proceedings, and served as an editor of the international journal Geotechnical News. Dr. Othman was a recipient of the 1994 American Society of Civil Engineers Collingwood Prize.
