Preview of September 2016 SAME Presentation. This presentation will be given by Mr. Jimmy Williams of the Houston County Fire Department.



On April 1st, an EF1tornado struck the city of Warner Robins. The city sustained some \$14M in damage along a 4.9 mile track that crossed the most heavily populated part of the city. It was the worst natural disaster to hit the city since the flood of July 1994. Fortunately, there were no causalities.

Chief Jimmy Williams, the Houston County Emergency Management Agency (HEMA) Director, was Incident Commander for this event and led the government, utility, and volunteer response. For this presentation, Chief Williams will talk about how HEMA and local officials had handled this event including assessing the damage that was caused by this natural disaster, coordinating the response, and helping the community by removing debris and providing assistance where needed.

Presenter's Bio:

Jimmy W. Williams, Jr has been in the Public Safety field since 1982 by starting out his career as a volunteer firefighter. In 1989, he became the Assistant Emergency Management Director and in 1994, he was promoted to Director and Fire Chief, holding that position today. Jimmy is an extremely active member of the local community and is a integral part of many organizations such as



the Houston County School System Safety Committee, the Southeastern Association of Fire Chiefs, and the Local Homeland Security Task Force just to name a few.

Currently, Jimmy serves as the Secretary-Treasurer of the Georgia Fire Chiefs Association and is the Coordinator for the Central Georgia Senior Leadership Training Seminar. Also, he is a founding member of the Safe Kids of Houston County and is the chairman of the Central Georgia Search and Rescue Task Force.

Originally from the town of Blackshear, Jimmy moved to Warner Robins at the age two. Marrying his high school sweetheart, Jimmy has two sons, age 16 and 11. He is an active member of the Second Baptist Church in Warner Robins and in his spare time, he enjoys spending time with his family and fishing.
